On behalf of PlumpJack, I am writing to oppose the Incorporation of the town of Olympic Valley

To date PlumpJack has not taken an official position, however, we have been following the efforts of the Incorporate Olympic Valley committee and have reviewed the incorporation application with LAFCO and feel it is necessary to voice our concerns over these efforts.

PlumpJack Squaw Valley Inn, located at the base of the mountain in Olympic Valley, has had many opportunities to interact with Placer County and feels strongly that we have the appropriate representation from our local Government, both county officials and elected official, all of whom we support. Furthermore, we are concerned about the long-term sustainability of an incorporation effort and the representation that just over 500 local residences will have over the efforts of homeowners and business owners in the valley. There are some very serious concerns over the long-term financial viability of the incorporation efforts. We are concerned about the economic issues the Valley could face in the event of a catastrophic event or the like.

If the efforts proceed, we would join our neighbors Squaw Valley Ski Holdings, The Resort at Squaw Creek, and The Squaw Valley Lodge, in the request for a full environmental impact report to be prepared. Additionally, the PlumpJack Squaw Valley Inn would respectfully request to be excluded from the boundaries of the proposed incorporation.
